6. Share an experience in which you provided a student or group of students with adapted physical education instruction which met desired goals.

7. What factors do you consider or what methods do you use when preparing lesson plans?

8. What is the state of your student records? What is one thing you would like to improve upon?

9. Provide an effective method you have used to evaluate the motor needs of individual students.

10. How do you create safe, orderly, and effective learning environments? Share an experience.

11. Provide an experience in which communicating behavioral observations and/or student progress reports to a student, parent, teacher, or administrator helped you in your work.

12. Share an experience in which you assisted in the placement of students in adapted physical education programs.

13. Describe an effective method you have used assess students' physical progress and/or needs.

14. Share an experience in which you successfully advised education professionals on students' physical abilities and the accommodations required to enhance their school performance.

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15. Provide an effective method you have used to adapt instructional techniques to the age and skill levels of students. Share an experience.

16. Share an experience in which you used adapted physical education techniques to improve physical fitness, gross motor skills, perceptual motor skills, and/or sports and game achievement.
