15. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?
16. How do you balance cooperation with others and independent thinking? Share an example. (Try to
determine if the candidate has a cooperative attitude or is otherwise good-natured.)

18. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?
19. Tell me about your last experience doing repair work. How did you determine what tools you needed?
20. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you
successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and
can demonstrate some initiative.)
21. Describe an experience when you unlocked cars and other vehicles.
22. Name a time when you installed alarm and electronic access system
23. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized
equpiment.
24. Name a time when your creativity or alternative thinking solved a problem in your workplace.
25. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, calibrated, or tested a device that operates
mainly by electronic principles.
26. Walk me through how you would repair and adjust safes, vault doors, and vault components, using hand
tools, lathes, drill presses, and welding and acetylene cutting apparatus.
27. Tell me about the last time you performed routine maintenance on equipment. How did you determine
when and what type of work was needed?
