2. Share an experience in which you've successfully learned how to handle a new piece of equipment?

3. Share effective methods to diagnose or repair problems with electronic equipment, such as sound, navigation, communication, and security equipment, in motor vehicles.

4. Walk me through how you inspect and test electrical or electronic systems to locate and diagnose malfunctions, using visual inspections and testing instruments such as oscilloscopes and voltmeters.

5. What kind of experience do you have installing equipment and accessories such as stereos, navigation equipment, communication equipment, and security systems?

6. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

7. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized equpiment.

8. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

9. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

10. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

11. Give me an example of when you thought outside of the box. How did it help your employer?

12. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

13. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.

14. Share an example of a time you had to gather information from multiple sources. How did you determine

which information was relevant?

15. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

16. Tell me about your last experience doing repair work. How did you determine what tools you needed?

17. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.

18. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.

19. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)

20. What is the most challenging part of estimating costs of repairs based on parts and labor charges?

21. What have you found to be the best way to confer with customers to determine the nature of malfunctions? Share an example.

22. Provide a time when you dealt calmly and effectively with a high-stress situation.

23. Tell me how you build fiberglass or wooden enclosures for sound components, and fit them to automobile dimensions.

24. Tell me about a time when you successfully determined the cause of an operating error at your company and solved the problem.

25. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?

26. Provide a time when you worked in a rapidly evolving workplace. How did you deal with the change? (Make sure the candidate is flexible.)

27. Provide an example of when you were persistent in the face of obstacles.

28. Share an example of when you established and accomplished a goal that was personally challenging. What helped you succeed?

29. Would you consider analyzing data or information a strength? How so?

30. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and can demonstrate some initiative.)

31. Name a time when your creativity or alternative thinking solved a problem in your workplace.

32. Tell me about the last time you performed routine maintenance on equipment. How did you determine when and what type of work was needed?

33. In your experience, what is the key to ensuring your company was compliant with all laws, regulations and standards that were applicable to your area of responsibility?

34. Provide an example of a time when you were able to demonstrate excellent listening skills. What was the situation and outcome?

35. How do you balance cooperation with others and independent thinking? Share an example. (Try to determine if the candidate has a cooperative attitude or is otherwise good-natured.)

36. Provide an example when your ethics were tested.

37. Share an experience in which you successfully installed a difficult piece of equipment. What made the situation so difficult?

38. What are some long-range objectives that you developed in your last job? What did you do to achieve them?

39. Share an experience in which your willingness to lead or offer an opinion helped your company.

40. Provide an experience in which you were sensitive to somone's needs or feelings. How did your helpfulness affect your work environment?

41. Share an experience in which you conducted a test of a product, service, or process and successfully improved the quality or performance.

42. Describe an experience in which you successfully controlled the operation of a difficult system. What made you successful?

43. Tell me about a time when you developed your own way of doing things or were self-motivated to finish an important task.

44. Provide an experience that demonstrates your ability to manage time effectively. What were the challenges and results?

45. Share an experience in which you successfully coordinated with others. How about a coordination effort that was not as successful?

46. Share an experience in which personal connections to coworkers or others helped you to be successful in your work. (Make sure candidate works well with others.)

47. Describe a time when you were able to select the best tool to do a job. How did you use reasoning skills to make the best choice?

48. How would you rate your writing skills? (Ask for an example that demonstrates great writing skills.)

49. Provide an experience in which your ability to actively find ways to help people improved your company or your own work ethic.
