

Licensed Occupational Therapy Assistant Interview Questions

1. What factors do you consider when selecting therapy activities?

2. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

3. Describe an experience in which you identified the educational needs of your students and successfully developed a way to teach/train them.

4. Describe a time when you successfully provided personal assistance to a coworker or patron.

5. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

6. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

7. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?

8. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

9. What are some long-range objectives that you developed in your last job? What did you do to achieve them?

10. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

11. Give me an example of when you thought outside of the box. How did it help your employer?

12. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

13. Would you consider analyzing data or information a strength? How so?

14. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?

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15. Share an example of a time you had to gather information from multiple sources. How did you determine which information was relevant?

16. Please share with me an example of how you helped coach or mentor someone. What improvements did you see in the person's knowledge or skills?

17. Provide an example when your ethics were tested.

18. Provide an experience in which you were sensitive to someone's needs or feelings. How did your helpfulness affect your work environment?

19. How do you balance cooperation with others and independent thinking? Share an example. (Try to determine if the candidate has a cooperative attitude or is otherwise good-natured.)

20. What is the state of your records? Name one thing you would like to improve.

21. What is the key to success when communicating with the public.

22. Share an experience in which communicating and collaborating with other healthcare professionals helped you to more effectively help a patient.

23. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)

24. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?

25. Share an effective method you have used to monitor patients' therapy activities. Share an experience in which you provided encouragement.

26. Provide an effective method you have used to promote positive attitudes toward clients and their treatment programs.

27. Provide an example of a time when you were able to demonstrate excellent listening skills. What was the

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situation and outcome?
28. Provide a time when you dealt calmly and effectively with a high-stress situation.
29. Provide a time when you worked in a rapidly evolving workplace. How did you deal with the change? (Make sure the candidate is flexible.)
30. What factors do you consider when implementing treatment plans to help clients function independently? Share an experience.
31. Provide an experience in which you effectively instructed patients and/or families in home programs, basic living skills, and/or adaptive equipment.
32. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.
33. Share an effective method you have used to evaluate the skills and capacities of disabled clients. Provide an experience.
34. Share an effective approach to working with a large amount of information/data. How has your approach affected your company?
35. Share an experience in which personal connections to coworkers or others helped you to be successful in your work. (Make sure candidate works well with others.)
36. Share an experience in which you effectively altered a treatment program to obtain better results.
37. Provide an experience in which you maintained equipment for patient use.
38. Provide an example when you were able to prevent a problem because you foresaw the reaction of another person.
39. How would you rate your writing skills? (Ask for an example that demonstrates great writing skills.)

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40. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and can demonstrate some initiative.)
41. Provide an effective method you have used to teach patients how to deal constructively with their emotions. Share an experience.
42. What have you found to be the best way to monitor the performance of your work and/or the work of others? Share a time when you had to take corrective action.
43. Share an experience in which attending a care plan meeting helped you to effectively update a care plan for a patient.
44. Name a time when your creativity or alternative thinking solved a problem in your workplace.
45. Provide an experience in which you effectively repaired or modified equipment.
46. Tell me about your experience performing clerical duties.
47. Name a time when your advice to management led to an improvement in your company or otherwise helped your employer.
48. Tell me about a time when you developed your own way of doing things or were self-motivated to finish an important task.
49. Share an experience in which you administered situational and/or diagnostic tests.
50. In your experience, what is the key to ensuring your company was compliant with all laws, regulations and standards that were applicable to your area of responsibility?
51. Share an experience in which your ability to consider the costs or benefits of a potential action helped you choose the most appropriate action.
52. Provide an experience in which your ability to actively find ways to help people improved your company

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or your own work ethic.

53. Share an experience in which you successfully coordinated with others. How about a coordination effort that was not as successful?

54. Name a time when you identified strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions to problems. What was the impact?

55. Please share an experience in which you presented to a group. What was the situation and how did it go?

56. Provide an example of when you were persistent in the face of obstacles.

57. In your experience, what is the key to developing a good team? (Look for how they build mutual trust, respect, and cooperation.)

58. Please share an experience in which you successfully taught a difficult principle or concept. How were you able to be successful?

59. Share an experience in which your willingness to lead or offer an opinion helped your company.

60. Share an example of when you established and accomplished a goal that was personally challenging. What helped you succeed?

61. Provide an experience that demonstrates your ability to manage time effectively. What were the challenges and results?

62. Share an experience in which you used new training skills, ideas, or a method to adapt to a new situation or improve an ongoing one. (Look for the candidate's ability to learn.)

63. Share an experience in which your understanding of a current or upcoming problem helped your company to respond to the problem.

64. Describe a time when you successfully persuaded another person to change his/her way of thinking or behavior.

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65. Describe an experience in which your ability to work well with others and reconcile differences helped your company or employer. (Make sure the candidate knows how to negotiate.)

66. Provide a time when you were able to identify a complex problem, evaluate the options, and implement a solution. How did the solution benefit your employer?

67. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.

68. Tell me about the last time you oversaw the work of someone else. How did you effectively motivate, develop, and direct the worker(s)?

69. Provide an example of a time when you successfully organized a diverse group of people to accomplish a task.
