Anesthesiologist Interview Questions

1. Describe what procedures you have in place to monitor patient before, during, and after anesthesia and
counteract adverse reactions or complications.
2. Tell me about how you record type and amount of anesthesia and patient condition throughout procedure.
3. Walk me through how you examine patient, obtain medical history, and use diagnostic tests to determine
risk during surgical, obstetrical, and other medical procedures.
4. Which techniques do you find most effective when administering anesthetic or sedation during medical
procedures, using local, intravenous, spinal, or caudal methods.
5. Share methods as to how you provide and maintain life support and airway management and help prepare
patients for emergency surgery.
6. Expound on how you decide when patients have recovered or stabilized enough to be sent to another room
or ward or to be sent home following outpatient surgery.
7. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.
8. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the
candidate has open lines of communication.)
9. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.
10. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your
company?
