

Antique Automobiles Repairer Interview Questions

1. Share an example where you followed supervisors' instructions as to which parts to restore or replace and how much time the job should take. Did you find it helpful?

2. What kind of experience do you have reviewing damage reports, prepared or reviewed repair cost estimates, and planned work to be performed?

3. Walk me through how you would fit and weld replacement parts into place, using wrenches and welding equipment, and grind down welds to smooth them, using power grinders and other tools.

4. Describe methods used to remove damaged sections of vehicles using metal-cutting guns, air grinders and wrenches, and install replacement parts using wrenches or welding equipment.

5. Tell me how you would chain or clamp frames and sections to alignment machines that use hydraulic pressure to align damaged components.

6. What procedures do you use to inspect repaired vehicles for proper functioning, completion of work, dimensional accuracy, and overall appearance of paint job, and test drive vehicles to ensure proper alignment and handling?

7. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

8. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

9. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.

10. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?
