1. Describe methods used to Inspect and test new vehicles for damage and record findings so that necessary repairs can be made.
2. What have you found to useful when troubleshooting fuel, ignition, and emissions control systems, using electronic testing equipment?
3. Walk me through how you examine vehicles, compile estimates of repair costs, and secure customers' approval to perform repairs.
4. Explain what kind of experience you have to repair, replace, or adjust defective fuel injectors, carburetor parts, and gasoline filters.
5. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.
6. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized equpiment.
7. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.
8. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?
9. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.
10. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)
