Door Installer Interview Questions

1. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.
2. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?
3. Describe an experience when you positioned and held timbers, lumber, or paneling in place for fastening or cutting.
4. What kind of experience do you have selecting tools, equipment, or materials from storage and transport items to work site?
5. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.
6. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)
7. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.
8. Provide a time when you worked in a rapidly evolving workplace. How did you deal with the change? (Make sure the candidate is flexible.)
9. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.
10. How do you balance cooperation with others and independent thinking? Share an example. (Try to determine if the candidate has a cooperative attitude or is otherwise good-natured.)
