

## Blow Down Operator Interview Questions

1. Share an example where you effectively monitored gauges, recording instruments, flowmeters, or products to ensure that specified conditions are maintained.

2. What kind of process would you use to observe safety precautions to prevent fires or explosions?

3. Tell me how you adjust controls to regulate temperature, pressure, feed, or flow of liquids or gases and times of prescribed reactions, according to knowledge of equipment and processes.

4. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

5. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized equipment.

6. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

7. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

8. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

9. Share an effective approach to working with a large amount of information/data. How has your approach affected your company?

10. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.
