1. Share an experience in which you measured finished workpieces to ensure conformance to specifications.

2. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.

3. Share an experience in which you've successfully learned how to handle a new piece of equipment?

4. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

5. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

6. What have you found to be the best way to monitor the performance of your work and/or the work of others? Share a time when you had to take corrective action.

7. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.

8. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

9. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?

10. Share an experience in which you conducted a test of a product, service, or process and successfully improved the quality or performance.
