3. Describe a time when you successfully provided personal assistance to a coworker or patron.
4. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best
solution to a problem.
5. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you
respond?
6. Share an example of a time you had to gather information from multiple sources. How did you determine
which information was relevant?
7. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the
candidate is dependable.)
8. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the
candidate has open lines of communication.)
9. Share an effective approach to working with a large amount of information/data. How has your approach
affected your company?
10. Tell me about a major meal which you prepared.
