2. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you

3. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you
respond?
4. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the
candidate has open lines of communication.)
5. Describe methods you have found effective to inspect, test, and adjust completed units to ensure that units
meet specifications, tolerances, and customer order requirements.
6. Share an effective process to position, align, and adjust parts for proper fit and assembly.
7. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.
8. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the
candidate is dependable.)
9. What system have you found effective to attach name plates and mark identifying information on parts?
10. Walk me through how you read blueprints and specifications to determine component parts and assembly
sequences of electromechanical units.
