1. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

2. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?

3. Share an experience in which you've successfully learned how to handle a new piece of equipment?

4. What kind of experience do you have steering vessels and operating navigational instruments?

5. How often do you need to maintain engines, fishing gear, and other on-board equipment; and perform minor repairs?

6. What have you found to be the best way to put fishing equipment into the water and anchor or tow equipment, according to the fishing method used?

7. Name a time when you located fish, using fish-finding equipment. What method did you find helpful?

8. What is the most challenging part of harvesting marine life for human or animal consumption, using diving or dredging equipment, traps, barges, rods, reels, and/or tackle?

9. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.

10. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)
