3. What is the most challenging part of moving picklocks in cylinders to open door locks without keys?

4. What kind of experience do you have installing safes, vault doors, and deposit boxes according to blueprints, using equipment such as powered drills, taps, dies, truck cranes, and dollies?

5. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

6. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.

7. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

8. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

9. Share an example of a time you had to gather information from multiple sources. How did you determine which information was relevant?

10. Provide an example when your ethics were tested.
