4. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

5. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

6. Share an experience in which you conducted a test of a product, service, or process and successfully improved the quality or performance.

7. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

8. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

9. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.

10. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?
