5. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

6. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

7. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

8. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

9. Tell me about your last experience doing repair work. How did you determine what tools you needed?

10. Tell me about the last time you performed routine maintenance on equipment. How did you determine when and what type of work was needed?
