5. Please share with me an example of how you helped coach or mentor someone. What improvements did

6. Describe an experience in which you identified the educational needs of your students and successfully
developed a way to teach/train them.
7. What is the key to success when communicating with the public.
8. Describe a time when you successfully provided personal assistance to a coworker or patron.
9. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.
10. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the
candidate has open lines of communication.)
