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| 4. What is the state of your student records? Name one thing you would like to improve. |
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| 5. Share an experience in which you successfully coordinated the placement of students with special needs into mainstream classes. |
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| 6. Provide an experience in which conferring with a parent or professional helped you to develop an effective individual education plan. |
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| 7. Share an experience in which collaborating with other teachers and/or administrators helped you to effectively develop or improve a preschool program. |
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| 8. Describe an experience in which you effectively improved your professional competence. What methods led to this improvement? |
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| 9. Provide an experience in which administering a test helped you to accurately determine a child's developmental level, needs, and/or potential. |
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| 10. Share an experience in which you successfully taught students personal development skills. |
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
