1. In your experience, what is the key to developing a good team? (Look for how they build mutual trust, respect, and cooperation.)

2. Describe a transportation system you designed and prepared plans for which you were happy with. How about one you designed which you were not as happy with?

3. What is the most challenging part of budgeting for you?

4. Name a time when your advice to management led to an improvement in your company or otherwise helped your employer.

5. Provide an example of when you set expectations and monitored the performance of subordinates. What guidance and direction did you find most effective?

6. Provide an example of a time when you successfully organized a diverse group of people to accomplish a task.

7. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

8. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

9. Share an experience in which you oversaw the assembly, fabrication, construction, maintenance, or modification of equipment. How did you communicate to the staff what you wanted?

10. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.
