7. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.
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14. Provide an experience that demonstrates your ability to manage time effectively. What were the challenges
and results?
15. What have you found to be the best way to monitor the performance of your work and/or the work of
others? Share a time when you had to take corrective action.
16. Name a time when you identified strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions to problems. What was
the impact?
17. Share a time when you successfully used scientific rules or methods to solve a problem at work.
18. Provide an example of a time when you were able to demonstrate excellent listening skills. What was the
situation and outcome?
19. Explain how you are able to position patient on operating table to maximize patient comfort and surgical
accessibility. Do you need help at times?
20. Provide a time when you dealt calmly and effectively with a high-stress situation.
