which information was relevant?

the impact?
8. Please share an experience in which you presented to a group. What was the situation and how did it go?
9. Provide an example of a time when you were able to demonstrate excellent listening skills. What was the
situation and outcome?
10. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.
11. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best
solution to a problem.
12. Tell me about a time when your ability to analyze needs and product requirements helped you create an
effective design or make an informed decision to benefit your company.
13. Name a time when your creativity or alternative thinking solved a problem in your workplace.
