2. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.
3. What kind of experience do you have driving vehicles with capacities under three tons to transport materials
to and from specified destinations, such as railroad stations, plants, residences, offices, or within industrial
yards?
4. Describe methods you have found useful to inspect and maintain vehicle supplies and equipment, such as
gas, oil, water, tires, lights, or brakes, to ensure that vehicles are in proper working condition.
5. Provide an example when your ethics were tested.
6. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the
candidate is dependable.)
7. What is the most challenging part of verifying the contents of inventory loads against shipping papers?
8. Why is it important to maintain records, such as vehicle logs, records of cargo, or billing statements, in
accordance with regulations?
9. Name a time when you drove trucks equipped with public address systems through city streets to broadcast
announcements for advertising or publicity purposes.
10. Tell me about a time when you developed your own way of doing things or were self-motivated to finish
an important task.
11. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last
company.
12. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you
identify a problem or the cause of a problem.
13. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?
