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| 4. Name a time when you cared for natural turf fields, making sure the underlying soil has the required                                    |
| composition to allow proper drainage and to support the grasses used on the fields.  |
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| 5. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?   |
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| 6. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.   |
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| 7. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.                                       |
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| 8. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized equpiment.                                |
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| 9. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)        |
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| 10. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles. |
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| 11. Tell me about a time when you developed your own way of doing things or were self-motivated to finish                                  |
| an important task.   |
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| 12. Share an example when you cared for established lawns by mulching, aerating, weeding, grubbing,  |
| removing thatch, or trimming or edging around flower beds, walks, or walls.  |
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| 13. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.                             |
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| 14. How do you balance cooperation with others and independent thinking? Share an example, (Try to   |

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| 15. What kind of experience do you have pruning or trimming trees, shrubs, or hedges, using shears, pruners, or chain saws?   |
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| 16. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?  |
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| 17. Describe methods you have found effective to mix and spray or spread fertilizers, herbicides, or insecticides onto grass, shrubs, or trees, using hand or automatic sprayers or spreaders.  |
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| 18. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and can demonstrate some initiative.) |
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| 19. Tell me how you provide proper upkeep of sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, fountains, planters, burial sites, or other grounds features.  |
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| 20. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?   |
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| 21. Provide an example of when you were persistent in the face of obstacles.  |
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| 22. What is the most challenging part of using irrigation methods to adjust the amount of water consumption and to prevent waste?   |
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| 23. What do you know about planting seeds, bulbs, foliage, flowering plants, grass, ground covers, trees, or shrubs and apply mulch for protection, using gardening tools?  |
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| 24. Describe an experience when you followed planned landscaping designs to determine where to lay sod, sow grass, or plant flowers or foliage.   |
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| 25. Name a time when your creativity or alternative thinking solved a problem in your workplace.  |
