2. Name a time when you performed emergency leak repairs and general maintenance for a variety of roof types.

3. What kind of experience do you have providing assistance to skilled roofers installing and repairing roofs, flashings, and surfaces?

4. What is the most challenging part of locating worn or torn areas in roofs?

5. Describe an effective method to apply shingles, gravel, or asphalt over the top layer of tar to protect the roofing material.

6. Give me an example of when you thought outside of the box. How did it help your employer?

7. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?

8. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.

9. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

10. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

11. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

12. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?

13. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)

14. Describe a time when you successfully provided personal assistance to a coworker or patron.

30. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and can demonstrate some initiative.)
