1. Share an experience in which your diligence of inspecting equipment, structures, or materials helped you identify a problem or the cause of a problem.

2. Provide an experience in which you mixed pesticides, herbicides, and fungicides for application to plants.

3. What is the key to success when communicating with the public.

4. Tell me about your qualifications for and your experience handling vehicles and/or mechanized equipment.

5. Tell me about a recent experience you've had working with your hands.

6. How do you stay fit in order to perform physical activities that are required in the workplace?

7. Tell me how you organize, plan, and prioritize your work.

8. Share an experience when you applied new technology or information in your job. How did it help your company?

9. Tell me about the last time you monitored or reviewed information and detected a problem. How did you respond?

10. Share an example of a time you had to gather information from multiple sources. How did you determine which information was relevant?

11. Describe a time when you successfully serviced, repaired, or tested a machine or device that operates mainly by mechanical principles.

12. Share an experience you had in dealing with a difficult person and how you handled the situation.

13. Share an experience in which you've successfully learned how to handle a new piece of equipment?

14. Share an experience in which you successfully shared a difficult piece of information. (Make sure that the candidate has open lines of communication.)

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15. Tell me about an experience in which you analyzed information and evaluated results to choose the best solution to a problem.

16. What factors do you consider when covering areas to specified depths with pesticides? Share an experience.

17. In your experience, what is the key to ensuring your company was compliant with all laws, regulations and standards that were applicable to your area of responsibility?

18. Share an example of when you went above and beyond the "call of duty". (Look for answers that show the candidate is dependable.)

19. Describe your experience starting motors and engaging machinery.

20. Share an experience in which your attention to detail and thoroughness had an impact on your last company.

21. What factors do you consider when selecting hoses and nozzles?

22. Share an effective approach to working with a large amount of information/data. How has your approach affected your company?

23. Tell me about a time when you developed your own way of doing things or were self-motivated to finish an important task.

24. Share an effective method you have used to ensure operating efficiency of machinery.

25. Provide an example when your ethics were tested.

26. Share a time when you willingly took on additional responsibilities or challenges. How did you successfully meet all of the demands of these responsibilities? (Make sure the candidate is a self-starter and can demonstrate some initiative.)

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27. Describe an experience in which you identified the educational needs of your students and successfully developed a way to teach/train them.

28. Provide a time when you worked in a rapidly evolving workplace. How did you deal with the change? (Make sure the candidate is flexible.)

29. Name a time when your patience was tested. How did you keep your emotions in check?

30. Provide an example of when you were persistent in the face of obstacles.
